Thank you for letting us represent you in Botswana and having an impact on Africa. As we recount God's blessings for 2015, we are thankful we could conduct 14 seminars; 9 within Botswana and 5 in other African countries. Our goal for 2016 is at least 15 seminars. This month thru March we have 5 scheduled; 3 in Botswana, one each in Swaziland, and Lesotho. Discussions are ongoing for seminars in Gabon, Rwanda, and South Africa.

Rev. Jeff Nelson, Vice-Chancellor of East Africa School of Theology, Kenya states: "I have been privileged to sit under Ken Krucker's ministry, Africa Financial Empowerment. I felt his teaching would be important for our students at East Africa School of Theology. He made a lasting impact on the students. Our missions giving increased tremendously during the weeks following Ken's ministry. Our students gave nearly US \$2,000 to missions in 10 weeks. Ken's sound biblical teaching on tithing and worshipping the Lord through giving is what the church needs today."

PURSUING A DREAM



In the Fall of 2006, the Lord put a dream in our hearts that we have prayerfully and passionately pursued - to prepare a place to train up, send out and reach "the least of these" around the world. December 4, 2014 we purchased 13 acres of this beautiful farm with plans to purchase another 13 acres by the end of 2015. This will be a missions' leadership training center and a camp, a place of refuge for 21,000 kids in our local church feeding programs.

Praise God, this past year the dream started to be a reality because so many gave faithfully.

The earth movers just finished three weeks of terracing the back 4 acres, prepping the land for cabins. The huge water tower with its foundation to hold the 6,600 gallon water tank is in, and the water lines to parts of the land from the main line on the street which is about 600 feet from the property. Thankfully we were able to build the 2 bathrooms and install the septic tank.

Almost done, thanks to all who gave and sacrificed during those 5 weeks! We have 650 linear meters of security wall up too. A big start and a long way to go. We are so grateful for the money that has come in for such an important part of the whole project, just over \$200,000 and we paid cash. God is so faithful, people have given generously and we are so thankful. Simply amazing! We serve a Great, Great God!!

A few construction teams are coming down this year to build 18x13 meter cabins, costing \$34,800 each. Our

goal is three this year and to put in our own well, costing \$35,000. Dare to dream with us for a chapel, a pool, a basketball court, soccer & baseball fields, high rope course, a technical training facility, and the rest of the security wall in the future. Sounds like a God-size dream! So thankful it's HIS project. Thankful and blessed for your partnership. "Teamwork makes the Dream work" for so many young people of Nicaragua.
